- Video Link introducing yourself and your advocacy ask
- Headshot & Resume
- TTAN Sponsorship / Permission Form
- Letter of Recommendation

Any freshman, sophomore or junior who is an inducted Thespian and is in good standing with his/her troupe may apply. Only one student per school may run for TTAN Student Ambassador. Finalists will complete a live interview.
